Privately Owned: Freight railroads operate on a nearly 140,000-mile network they almost exclusively own, maintain and pay for themselves.




Sustainable: Railroads are the most fuel efficient way to move freight over land. It would have taken approximately 6.6 million additional trucks to handle the 118.9 million tons of freight that originated by rail in Illinois in 2021.



Economic Driver: Railroads haul 1/3 of U.S. exports and serve nearly every sector of the economy, from moving the food we eat to the chemicals that treat our water.

Rail Traffic Originated in 2021 Total Tons: 118.9 million Total Carloads: 4,002,900







Short Line Railroad: A railroad which is neither a Class I nor a Regional Railroad.
